Quality control of construction materials and the product is an essential requirement for obtaining an improved and uniform standard of road construction. It depends on the requirement of design standards, the material used and workmanship during construction. Improved level of service of roads & highways will result in considerable savings in vehicle operating costs and favourable road user reaction and public opinion. The extra cost of exercising quality control is only a fraction of the resulting benefits. The direct and indirect economic return from quality control could be of the order of 5 to 10 per cent of the total construction cost.

Site supervision also plays a major part to ensure compliance with the requirement. Proper documentation in the daily records is a basic requirement in roadworks construction. Checklists for each stage of roadworks construction can assist and be used as guidelines for proper documentation.
